Course Description

This course introduces the basics of conversational German through the development of listening, speaking, reading and writing skills. Students will learn introductions and greetings and will learn vocabulary pertaining to family, recreation, weather, school, travel and food. Students will explore aspects of the German culture by learning about the history, heritage and people which represent the 5 German speaking countries.

Student Activities

Students will use songs, video clips and simple Educational Soap Operas to enhance learning. They will use their iPad to create their own instructional videos, to record their voices, to create travel brochures and to email pen pals in both Austria and Germany. In culture they will use iPads to research information regarding culture, history and architecture found in the 16 German states. At the end of the course students will learn to prepare an original German meal.
