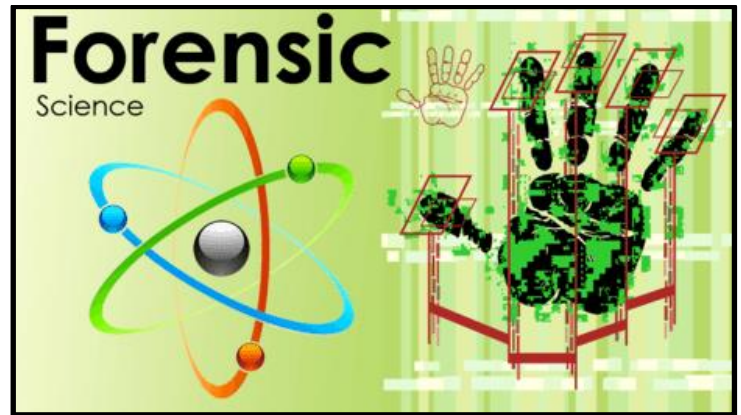


Forensic Science
