Course Description

The Pre-AP Japanese III provides for an in-depth development of communication skills introduced in the previous courses. Further expansion of vocabulary, grammatical structures, and Chinese characters continues. Students are expected to develop communication skills in various real life settings.

The course introduces various topics regarding Japanese culture and its language. Students explore Japanese geography and history, traditional and modern culture including art, music, food, movies, etc.

Student Activities

Various topics will be introduced throughout the course including Japanese homes, lifestyles, daily lives, annual events, environment, education, technology, leisure, travel, festivals, and so on. As part of cultural learning, students will explore Japanese literature, including poetry, art, music, and food.
