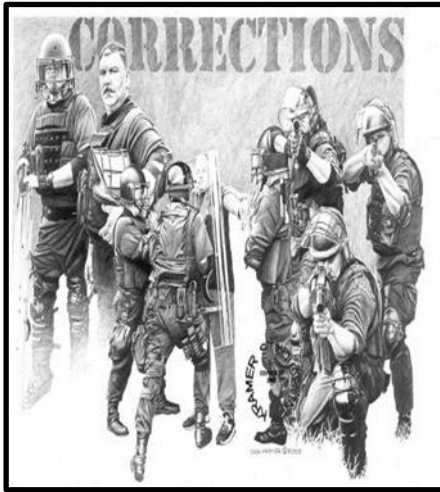


Correctional Services
