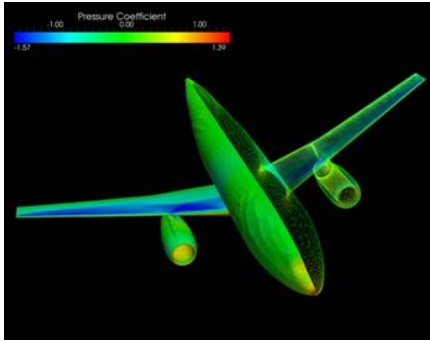


Engineering Design & Development
