## **The Program**

The TREC Health Science Academy will provide students:

- \* An academic curriculum that prepares them for entry into a university level Health Professions Education Program.
- \* Central Sterile Processing Certification including clinical hours.
- \* Access to courses that are conducted at the TCC Trinity River East Campus.
- \* **59** college credit hours while meeting Mansfield ISD High School graduation requirements upon completion of the two-year program.

## **Student Application Requirements**

- \* MUST be an FHS student
- \* MUST be an entering Junior year
- \* MUST have 16 credits entering Junior year
- \* On the Distinguished Level of Achievement graduation plan
- \* Has a 90% or higher overall GPA
- \* Will have met TSI Assessment requirements by the end of Sophomore year
- \* Earned credit for and received an 85 or higher average in Algebra 1 and Geometry/Pre-AP Geometry with an 85 or higher average OR currently enrolled in Geometry/Pre-AP Geometry and will receive an 85 or higher average
- \* MUST have met the standard on all EOC exams
- \* Understand FHS and TREC are a 2-year commitment
